- Ensure adequate resource is provided to support the intentions of this policy.
- Establish, implement and maintain processes for the elimination of hazards and reduction of occupational health and safety risks, using the hierarchy of control.
- Provide all necessary safety devices and personal protective equipment and supervise their correct use.
- Provide a constant and continued interest in Health & Safety matters applicable to the company's
 activities, in particular by consulting, informing and involving employees or their representatives.
- Carry out and regularly review risk assessments to identify hazards and existing control
 measures; we will prioritise, plan and complete any corrective actions required to reduce risk to
 an acceptable level.
- Ensure their employees enter into the spirit and operation of this policy by: working safely and efficiently.
- Report Incidents that may lead or have led to injury or damage.
- Co-operate and assist in the investigation of all incidents with the main objective of introducing measures to prevent a recurrence.
