Highest rating for environment and ethics

EcoVadis assesses companies on 21 sustainability criteria in the four core areas of environment, labour and human rights, ethics and sustainable procurement. The environmental performance of Jungheinrich was again awarded the highest rating this year. Jungheinrich has also made clear improvements in the field of ethics.



As part of the Science Based Targets initiative, Jungheinrich has committed itself to achieving net-zero emissions by 2050 along the entire value chain (Scopes 1 to 3). Another factor in achieving the outstanding environment rating was the company's comprehensive and transparent sustainability reporting. For instance, Jungheinrich provides its customers with comprehensive insights into the environmental impact of its product series through product carbon footprints.
