*The previous year's figures have been adjusted and take into consideration the impacts on earnings reported in the interim statement as of 30 September 2019 and which almost balanced each other out.

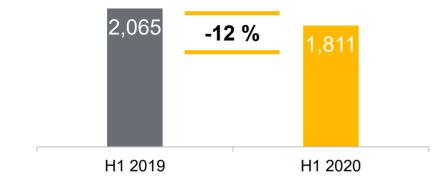

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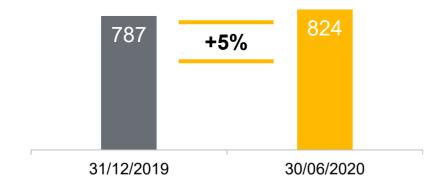
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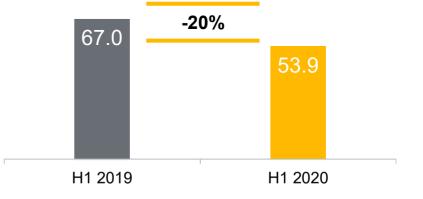
Incoming orders, in € million



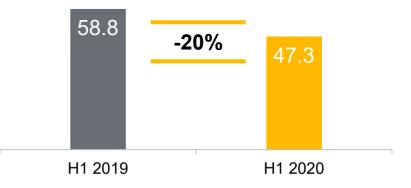
Orders on hand, in € million



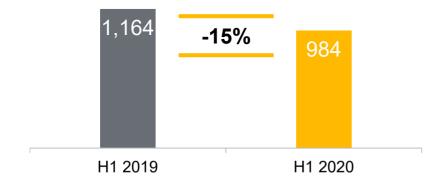
Incoming orders, in thousand units



Production, in thousand units

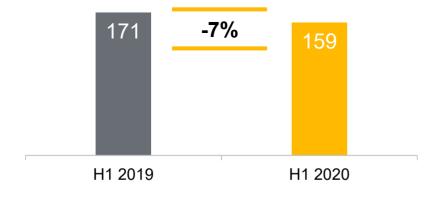


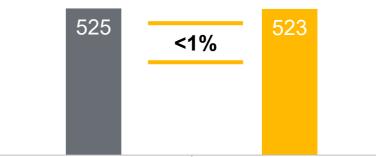
H1 2020: Revenue by business fields (Intralogistics)

New truck business, in € million

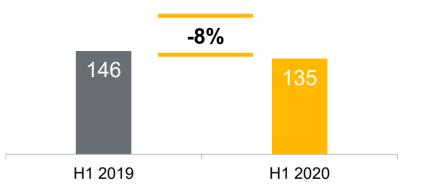
