

INFORMATION on using RSIGN for signing contracts electronically

Dear Jungheinrich customer,

In the future, Jungheinrich would like to simplify the contract signing process for our customers in order to reduce both the time and other expenditure associated with the need for a handwritten signature on all contracts.

This letter is to inform you that new contracts as well as any amendment or addition to existing contracts will be digitalised and signed electronically in the future. The transaction will take place via the platform "RSIGN software from the Swiss company Frama Communications AG, based at Dorfstrasse 6, CH-3438 Lauperswil, Switzerland, provided with the ID no.CHE-336.741.093 VAT". RSIGN is a software solution for processing and documenting the electronic signature of a document. With this software, a document is sent and signed and added with other necessary information (e.g., date of signature) electronically. In doing so, all steps or events associated with this document can be traced, ensuring its immutability.

The process of the electronic signature is executed as follows (and is largely identical in process to that of other electronic signature providers such as DocuSign, Adobe Sign, Eversign, SignNow):

- 1) Once the contents of the contract documents have been finally agreed, they will be made by sending an email available to the notified signatories via RSIGN for signature. In addition, the email will also include the data protection provisions applicable to the electronic signature service.
- 2) Open the documents via the link in the email and follow the steps indicated to formalise the signatures provided in it.
- 3) As soon as you have signed the documents, the signed documents will be made available to Jungheinrich via RSIGN and Jungheinrich will also sign the documents via RSIGN.
- 4) Once the document has been signed by all signatories of both parties, the final signed document is automatically sent to all signatories, bearing all signatures.

Prerequisite for the use of electronic signature system:

At least one (or all) duly authorized signatories must be made known to Jungheinrich in advance, with their name and email address provided. However, RSIGN also includes a forwarding option, if you do not yet know precisely which signatory and/or second signatory (if second signature is required) is available or is to sign the document. In all cases, please provide the e-mail address of the signatory only with the e-mail address related to the signatory (e.g. john.sample@businessname.hu) and avoid the use of general e-mail addresses (e.g. sales@businessname.hu or info@businessname.hu).

Legal remark:

The electronic signature created by using the RSIGN system has legal force in those contracts we apply it for. According to the current legislation, it is legally equivalent to the handwritten signature on paper; it is a so-called Advanced e-Signature ("AES").

If you also want to use your contract for a tender, please note that the conditions for the validity of electronic signatures may vary from one tender to another. Therefore, we kindly ask you to always check the details of the tender conditions regarding electronic signatures and please inform your contact at Jungheinrich immediately by email before signing the contract. Compliance is your responsibility and Jungheinrich will not be liable for any failure to comply.

The use of the electronic signature described is not mandatory, however we hope you will support our new, fast, easy and secure contracting process. Should you not wish to use the digital signature process, please inform your contact at Jungheinrich immediately by email.
